- Taking into account** the "Regolamento sull'amministrazione, sulla contabilità e sull'attività contrattuale" of INAF entered into force on Oct 24th, 2004;
- Taking into account** the "Regolamento del Personale" of INAF entered into force on Jan 1st, 2005;
- Taking into account** Italian Law n. 240, Dec 30th, 2010;
- Taking into account** the INAF Regulations for the awarding of research fellowships approved by INAF Administrative Council on June 22nd, 2011, Resolution n. 06/11 and subsequent modifications and integrations;
- In accordance with** the Grant Agreement n. 283783 for the implementation of the project "GLORIA – GLObal Robotic telescopes Intelligent Array for e-Science"
- In accordance with** the request for a call offering one research fellowship, submitted by the scientific responsible of the project "GLORIA" Dr. Luciano Nicastro, prot. n.00529/I/2012, December 12th, 2012;
- Considering** it appropriate to issue an announcement of competition for the award of a research fellowship;
- Given** the availability of finance from fund FP7 Grant Agreement n. 283783, CRA 2.05.48, "GLORIA – GLObal Robotic telescopes Intelligent Array for e-Science", of the 2013 INAF budget;

DECREES



Art. 1 – Research project

A selection based on titles and qualifications, possibly integrated by an interview, is open to award one research fellowship, “Assegno di Ricerca”, category POST-DOC, entitled “Support software for the GLORIA project data handling”.

GLORIA (GLObal Robotic telescopes Intelligent Array for e-science) is a project funded by the European Commission under the 7th Framework Programme. It involves 13 Institutions from 8 countries. GLORIA is an innovative citizen-science network of robotic telescopes, which will give free access and research opportunities to a virtual community via the Internet. The GLORIA partners will offer access to a growing collection of robotic telescopes via Web 2.0 - 17 telescopes on 4 continents by the end of 2014. The aims of the project also include the realization of open standards and methodologies to perform observations, management and analysis of live and archival astronomical data. Among the challenges that the project has to face there is the efficient access by the users to the very large (and continuously growing) archive of images that the heterogeneous set of GLORIA telescopes will collect.

The awarded fellow will carry out the following activities:

- Development of Web based rich Internet applications aimed at browsing astronomical data collected by optical and IR telescopes;
- Development of astronomical images management tools for distributed relational or NoSQL databases;
- Development of methodologies and tools aimed at accessing very large astronomical catalogues and data archives;
- Improving the capabilities of existing open source software libraries and contributing to their documentation.

Art. 2 – Requirements

Applicants must fulfill the following requirements, on pain of exclusion, in order to participate in the selection:

- PhD degree in Astronomy or Physics or Engineer's degree awarded by an Italian university or by a foreign university;
- Or
- Degree in Astronomy or Physics or Engineer's degree which would formally entitle for the admission to a doctorate, awarded by an Italian university or by a foreign university, together with at least three years of documented experience in scientific or technological activities;

And

- A professional level of knowledge of the English language;
- Good programming skills in at least two of the following languages: C, C++, PHP, Perl, Python, JavaScript;
- Good knowledge of the relational database principles;
- Good knowledge of the Linux operative system.

Preferential qualification will be considered the PhD degree and one or more of the following expertise:

- Object programming;
- JavaScript programming;
- UDF programming and management of relational and NoSQL databases;
- Web 2.0 programming;
- Web interface programming via RIA and within the LAMP environment.

Art. 3 – Application procedure

Applications must be submitted in English, by **February 4th 2013**, by registered mail with acknowledgement of receipt or express courier to the following address **“INAF/IASF-Bologna, Via P. Gobetti 101, 40129 Bologna (BO) - Italy”**, or e-mail to **“direzione@iasfbo.inaf.it”**.

Only applications submitted by the above mentioned date will be accepted. Late submissions will not be considered.

Applications which are not consistent with the attached forms (annexes 1, 2) or without the applicant's signatures will be excluded from the selection procedure.

The application must be delivered reporting on the envelope, or email subject, **“Assegno di Ricerca GLORIA”**.

The applicant must state clearly and precisely in the application, under his/her own responsibility:

- name(s) and surname, date and place of birth, nationality, place of residence and address for correspondence;
- that s/he satisfies all the requirements described in article 2 of this Call;
- that s/he is aware of and is not ineligible under any of the restrictions described in article 4 of this Call.

The lack of any of the above mentioned declarations will determine the exclusion from the selection procedure for incomplete application.

The following documents have to be submitted:

- Application form (*Attachment 1*);
- Curriculum vitae, signed and dated by the applicant, providing evidence of possession of the skills required to carry out the research and including a list, if applicable of grants and fellowships hold in the past; Degree mark should be reported too;
- copy of a valid identity document (ID card or passport);
- copy of the Degree which would formally entitle to embark on a doctorate;
- copy of the PhD certificate or of the equivalent foreign academic qualification (if applicable);
- list of publications;
- any document demonstrating other qualification, working task, research activity at public and private institutions and publications that the applicant deems appropriate to submit (copies are acceptable).

The documents that are required to be provided (or submitted) in copy, shall have in attachment the **declaration of equivalence to the original**, foreseen by the Italian law, written using the form in *Attachment 2*.

INAF accepts no responsibility for the loss of applications or documents where due to the applicant having provided incorrect contact details or having failed or delayed in notifying changes of these details, or to problems with postal or electronic delivery not due to INAF.

Art. 4 – Ineligibility and incompatibility with other funding

The Research fellowship cannot be held by INAF employees holding both permanent and non-permanent contracts, nor by regular employees of Institutes listed in article 22, paragraph 1 of Italian Law n. 240/2010.

The grant cannot be held contemporarily with attendance at academic courses, “laurea specialistica” academic courses, and “laurea magistrale” academic courses, or with attendance at PhD courses with fellowship. For employees of the Italian Public Administration compulsory unpaid leave of absence is foreseen.



The grant cannot be held contemporarily with other fellowships of whatever kind, except those awarded with the aim of integrating the training or research activity of the fellowship holder through a period spent abroad. Aggregation of income from working activities, also part-time, carried out continuously is not accepted. Instead, limited self-employed occasional work is compatible with the grant, only if this is not prejudicial to the research activity carried out for INAF. This must be authorized in advance by the Director of INAF/IASF-Bologna where most part of the research activity of the grant is carried out.

When formally accepting the grant, the successful candidate will issue a declaration of absence of inadmissible cumulating of grants/fellowships.

Retired persons are not eligible for Research fellowship.

Also excluded from participation are persons who have carried out Research fellowships under article 22 of Italian Law n. 240/2010 for a total period exceeding four years, including extensions, but excluding the periods in which the grant has been held in coincidence with doctoral studies up to the maximum legal time limit of the course and excluding periods of maternity leave or sick leave, in accordance with current legislation.

Art. 5 – Duration of the Research fellowship

The Research fellowship is for **12 months** (with possible extension depending on favorable opinion of the scientist in charge of the project, Dr. Luciano Nicastro, and on funding availability).

In accordance with Italian Law n. 240/2010 the duration of the fellowship, inclusive of possible renewal, will not exceed four years, (excluding the periods in which the grant has been held in coincidence with doctoral studies up to the maximum legal time limit of the course and) excluding periods of maternity leave or sick leave, in accordance with current legislation.

Art. 6 – Host Institution

The fellow will carry out the research at INAF/IASF-Bologna.

Art. 7 – Salary amount

The gross annual salary will be **30,000.00** (Thirtythousand/00) Euro. This amount is net of burdens to be charged to INAF/IASF-Bologna, social charges and health coverage and will be paid in deferred monthly installments.

Applicable fiscal rules are the provisions of art. n. 4 of Italian law n. 476/1984 and subsequent modifications and integrations. Applicable social security rules are art. n. 2, paragraph 26 and following paragraphs of the Italian Law n. 335/1995 and subsequent modifications and integrations. Applicable rules for obligatory maternity leave are provided in the Decree of the Italian Ministry of Labour and Social Security dated 12 July 2007, published in the “Gazzetta Ufficiale” n. 247, October 23rd 2007. Applicable rules for sick leave are provided by art. n. 1, paragraph n. 788 of Italian law n. 296, December 27 2006, and subsequent modifications.

During the period of obligatory maternity leave, the allowance paid by INPS (Italian National Institute for Social Security) according to art. n. 5 of the above Decree dated 12 July 2007 is supplemented by INAF up to the total amount of the grant. The period of obligatory maternity leave will not contribute to the duration of the grant foreseen by the contract.

The INAF/IASF-Bologna provides accidents and civil liability insurance cover from fund CRA 2.05.48 “GLORIA – GLOBAL Robotic telescopes Intelligent Array for e-Science”.

Art. 8 – Selection Committee and selection procedure

The selection will be performed by a Selection Committee appointed by the Director of INAF/IASF-Bologna and is composed of three members, including the scientist in charge of the project.

The selection is based on Degree mark, titles and qualifications, possibly integrated by an interview.



The Selection Committee can establish a short list of the eligible applicants to be interviewed, even using Internet tools, on the basis of titles and qualifications as well as documented experience in the scientific or technological activities on the specific subject of the research fellowship.

Applicants selected for the interview will be summoned with 15 days notice.

The total ranking score is 100 points: a maximum of 70 for titles and qualifications, and a maximum of 30 for the interview. The Selection Committee will define a minimum score for selecting eligible candidates.

At the conclusion of the selection procedure the Selection Committee will draw up the ranked list of the eligible candidates.

The approval decree of the selection procedure and the ranked list will be published on INAF/IASF-Bologna web site: "<http://www.iasfbo.inaf.it>".

Art. 9 – Awarding of the fellowship

The highest ranked candidate will receive written notification of award of the research fellowship.

Within 10 days from receipt of the formal notification of the award she/he must provide a formal declaration of acceptance of the research grant. The declaration will also state that she/he is not subject to any of the exclusion conditions listed in article 4 of this Call.

If it occurs, the awarded candidate is bound to provide formal declaration of withdrawal within the same time limit of 10 days.

Under no circumstances the signing of the contract starts a subordinate employment relationship or ensures any rights to access to permanent INAF staff positions.

Art. 10 – Starting date and fellowship obligations

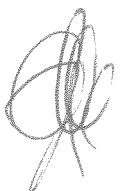
Expected starting date of the research fellowship is **March 2013**.

The holder of the fellowship:

- will start the research activity at the date due as for the contract at INAF/IASF-Bologna, unless prevented by force majeure or exceptional circumstances, of which the Director of INAF/IASF-Bologna must be timely informed;
- will carry out her/his research activities under the supervision of the scientist in charge of the project, Dr. Luciano Nicastro, who will also monitor the fellow's progress;
- is required to issue periodical activity reports: at least one report per year. The activity reports will be subject to approval from the scientist in charge of the project and will be transmitted to the Director of INAF/IASF-Bologna. Approval failing, duly reasoned by the scientist in charge, will give INAF/IASF-Bologna the right to terminate the contract;
- is required to send a written note in case of withdrawal, with at least 30 days notice, otherwise the INAF/IASF-Bologna is entitled to retain or request the reimbursement of the salary amount corresponding to the notice time-span she/he has failed to send.

The holder of the fellowship who does not carry out her/his research activity regularly without producing justified reasons or lacks repeatedly to fulfill requirements or, according to the evaluation of the scientist in charge of the project, eventually shows evident lack of skills at the planned research activities, will incur the termination of the contract.

Temporary suspensions of the research fellowship are due in case of obligatory maternity leave or in case of illness lasting longer than one month or to any other serious reason. The reasons for suspending the research fellowship must be proved and certified, and promptly sent to the Director of INAF/IASF-Bologna.



Art. 11 – Personal Data

In accordance with art. 13, paragraph 1 of the Italian Legislative Decree n. 196/2003 and subsequent modifications, personal data provided by the candidates will be used exclusively for the purposes of this selection.

Candidates wishing to obtain further information, or to exercise their rights under the art. 7 of the above mentioned Legislative Decree, may contact the Responsible for the administration of this call.

Art. 12 – Administration Responsible


Art. 13 – Applicable regulation

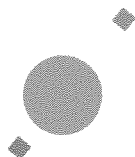

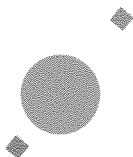
