Selection procedure based on qualifications and possibly an interview for one postdoctoral research fellowship (Assegno di Ricerca - Tipologia A POST-DOC), as part of the ERC Advanced Research Grant project "DARKLIGHT: Illuminating Dark Energy with the Next Generation of Cosmological Redshift Surveys".

- Taking into account** the "Decreto Legislativo 4 giugno 2003, n. 138 - Riordino dell'Istituto Nazionale di Astrofisica (INAF)" published on G.U. n. 140, 19 June 2003;
- Taking into account** the INAF Statute, approved on 7 March 2011, and effective as of 1 May 2011;
- Taking into account** the INAF "Disciplinare di organizzazione e funzionamento dell'INAF" as of 03 May 2012;
- Taking into account** the INAF "Regolamento sull'amministrazione, sulla contabilità e sull'attività contrattuale" as of 24 Oct 2004;
- Taking into account** the INAF "Personnel Rules and Regulations" as of 1 Jan 2005;
- Taking into account** Italian Law n. 240, 30 Dec 2010;
- Taking into account** the INAF Regulations for the awarding of research fellowships approved by the Administrative Council on 22 June 2011, Resolution n. 06/11;
- Given** the successful outcome of the European Research Council (ERC) Advanced Research Grant proposal n.291521 "DARKLIGHT: ILLUMINATING DARK ENERGY WITH THE NEXT GENERATION OF COSMOLOGICAL REDSHIFT SURVEYS", submitted by Dr. Luigi Guzzo to the European Research Council Call for Proposals ERC-2011-AdG;
- Given** the successful completion of the negotiations between INAF, ERC and Dr. Luigi Guzzo, and the signature of the Grant Agreement on 15 February 2012;
- Given** the total amount of 1,723,600 Euro awarded to the project, of which 603,260 Euro have been already transferred to INAF – OAB;

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Given

the obligation of the “beneficiary”, namely INAF - Observatory of Brera, to ensure the necessary scientific autonomy to Dr. L. Guzzo (*principal investigator*, of the ERC Advanced Grant project) in particular as regards the selection of other *team members*, hosted and engaged by the *beneficiary* (OAB) or other legal entities, in line with profiles needed to conduct the research, including the appropriate advertisement (as described in the *Supplementary Agreement* for the aforementioned Advanced Grant);

DECREES

Art. 1 – Research project

A selection based on titles and qualifications, possibly integrated by an interview, is open to award **a research fellowship, “Assegno di Ricerca – Tipologia A POST-DOC”**, entitled **“DARKLIGHT: Design and development of cosmological numerical simulations”**.

DARKLIGHT is a cosmology program funded by a 5-year ERC Advanced Grant awarded in 2012 to Dr. Luigi Guzzo. Its goal is to improve the techniques to extract cosmological information from galaxy redshift surveys, focusing on redshift-space distortions and their combination with other probes of large-scale structure.

The successful applicant will perform research in collaboration with Dr. Luigi Guzzo and the other members of the DARKLIGHT program. He/she will be expected to devise, design and develop n-body simulations aimed at exploring different cosmological scenarios, testing the effectiveness of the analysis techniques developed by the DARKLIGHT project.

Art. 2 – Requirements

According to the Italian law for “Assegni di Ricerca” applicants must fulfill the following requirements in order to participate in the selection:

- Doctorate in Astronomy or Physics or equivalent, obtained from an Italian or foreign University
- Previous experience with cosmological simulations and the use of n-body codes
- Excellent command of the English language

Further, experience in one or more of the following “Darklight themes” will be considered as an asset (“titolo preferenziale”):

- Dark energy and modified gravity models
- Cosmological constraints from galaxy survey data
- Cosmic Microwave Background
- Combination of galaxy clustering measurements and CMB

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Art. 3 – Application procedure

Applications should be sent **in electronic form** (PDF), to the attention of Mr Luca Ciarfaglia e Dr. Luigi Guzzo at the addresses: luigi.guzzo@brera.inaf.it and luca.ciarfaglia@brera.inaf.it. Only applications received **by 25 March 2014** will be taken into full consideration. Please quote reference "**DARKLIGHT Fellowship**" on all correspondence. **A printed copy of the application, properly signed, must also be sent by standard mail at the following address: Ufficio Concorsi – INAF - Osservatorio Astronomico di Brera, Via Brera 28, 20121 Milano, Italy**

A. The applicant should send the following documents:

- (1) Application Form, as available in Annex 1, duly filled in;
- (2) Curriculum Vitae, **signed and dated**, detailing in particular the past experiences on the subject of this fellowship;
- (3) Statement of research interests and qualifications;
- (4) List of publications;
- (5) Copy of a valid identity document (ID card or passport);

B. In the Application Form, the applicant must explicitly state, under his/her own responsibility:

- Name(s) and surname, date and place of birth, nationality, place of residence and address for correspondence;
- That he/she satisfies all the requirements described in article 2 of this Call;
- That he/she is aware of and is not ineligible under any of the restrictions described in Article 4 of this Call.

The lack of any of the above mentioned statements would determine the exclusion from the selection procedure for incomplete application.

C. The applicant should also arrange to have two letters of reference by scientists familiar with his/her work, sent to the same e-mail addresses (luca.ciarfaglia@brera.inaf.it and luigi.guzzo@brera.inaf.it).

The successful candidates will have to provide OA-Brera administration, before the end of the Academic Year 2013-2014, with copy of the PhD certificate or of an equivalent foreign academic qualification.

It is the responsibility of the applicant to provide correct contact details for communication purposes. INAF accepts no responsibility for any miscommunication that may arise due to inaccurate contact details or if such details are out of date. INAF also denies liability for any problem related to the postal delivery service.

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Art. 4 – Ineligibility and incompatibility with other funding

The Research fellowship cannot be held either by INAF employees (holding both permanent and non-permanent contracts), nor by regular employees of Institutes listed in article 22, paragraph 1 of Italian Law n. 240/2010. Fellowship holders are not allowed to enroll in a “Laurea Specialistica”, or “Laurea Magistrale” (Master Level) degrees, or to enter a PhD program covered by a separate fellowship. For employees of the Italian Public Administration, a compulsory unpaid leave of absence is foreseen. Retired persons are also not eligible for this research fellowship.

The fellowship cannot be held contemporarily with other fellowships of any kind, except those awarded with the aim of integrating the training or research activity of the fellowship holder through a period spent abroad. Aggregation of income from working activities, also part-time, carried out continuously is not accepted. Instead, limited self-employed occasional work is compatible with the fellowship, only if this is not prejudicial to the research activity carried out for INAF. This must be authorized in advance by the Director of INAF/OA-Brera, where most part of the research activity is carried out.

When formally accepting the fellowship, the successful candidate will declare that he/she is not cumulating fellowships. Also excluded are persons who have been beneficiaries of Research fellowships under article 22 of Italian Law 240/2010 for a total period exceeding four years, including extensions, but excluding the periods in which the fellowship has been held in coincidence with Doctoral studies (up to the maximum legal time limit of the course), as well as periods of maternity leave or sick leave, in accordance with current legislation.

Art. 5 – Duration of the research fellowship

The Research fellowship is initially awarded for **12 months** and can be further extended, upon availability of funding and a positive assessment by the responsible of the research project, Dr. Luigi Guzzo. In accordance with the Italian Law n. 240/2010 the total duration of the fellowship will not in any case exceed four years (excluding periods of maternity leave or sick leave, in accordance with current legislation.)

Art. 6 – Host Institution

The fellow will carry out the research at the Merate premises of INAF Osservatorio di Brera, where the DARKLIGHT program is located.

Art. 7 – Salary

The gross yearly salary for this position will be **30,000.00 (Thirty-thousand/00) Euro**. This amount is net of burdens to be charged to INAF/OA-Brera and will be paid in deferred monthly installments.

Applicable fiscal rules are the provisions of art. n. 4 of Italian law n. 476/1984 and subsequent modifications and integrations. Applicable social security rules are defined by art. n. 2, paragraph 26 and following paragraphs of the Italian Law n. 335/1995 and subsequent

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modifications and integrations. Applicable rules for obligatory maternity leave are provided in the Decree of the Italian Ministry of Labour and Social Security dated 12 July 2007, published in the "Gazzetta Ufficiale" n. 247, October 23rd 2007. Applicable rules for sick leave are provided by art. n. 1, paragraph n. 788 of Italian law n. 296, December 27 2006, and subsequent modifications.

During the period of obligatory maternity leave, the allowance paid by INPS (Italian National Institute for Social Security) according to art. n. 5 of the above Decree dated 12 July 2007 is supplemented by INAF up to the total amount of the fellowship. The period of obligatory maternity leave will not contribute to the maximum duration of the fellowship foreseen by the contract.

INAF/OA-Brera provides accident and civil liability insurance coverage through the ERC Advanced Grant support. The insurance policy does not cover civil liability of the fellowship holder towards INAF.

Art. 8 – Selection Committee and selection procedure

The selection will be performed by a Selection Committee appointed by the Director of INAF/OA Brera and is composed of three members, including the scientist in charge of the project. The selection is based on qualifications, possibly integrated by an interview. The Selection Committee can establish a short list of the eligible applicants to be interviewed, on the basis of titles and qualifications and documented experience in the scientific or technological activities on the specific subject of the research fellowship. If approved by all members of the Committee, the interviews can be performed via videoconference, to ease the procedure for foreign candidates and reduce costs. Applicants selected for the interview will be summoned with 15 days notice.

The total ranking score is 100 points: a maximum of 70 for titles and qualifications, and a maximum of 30 for the interview. At the conclusion of the selection procedure the Selection Committee will produce a ranked list.

Art. 9 – Awarding of the fellowship

The highest-ranked candidate will receive a written notification with an offer of the research fellowship, which will be anticipated by e-mail to assure a speedy process. Within 7 days from receipt of the formal notification of the award she/he must provide a formal declaration of acceptance of the fellowship, or of withdrawal. The declaration can also be anticipated by electronic mail. In case no declaration is received, the candidate is considered as withdrawn and thus excluded. The committee can then move down the ranking and repeat the procedure with the second-ranked candidate, and so on, until the fellowship is accepted.

Under no circumstances the signing of the contract will start a subordinate employment relationship or ensures any rights to access to permanent INAF staff positions.

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Art. 10 – Starting date and fellowship obligations

Expected starting date of the research fellowship is 1st April 2014, but an earlier date is possible. The holder of the fellowship:

- Will start the research activity on due date, as for the contract with INAF - OA-Brera, unless prevented by force majeure or exceptional circumstances, of which the Director of INAF – OA Brera must be timely informed;
- Will carry out her/his research activities under the supervision of the Principal Investigator of the project, Dr. Luigi Guzzo, who will also monitor the fellow's progress;
- Is required to issue periodical activity reports as established in the contract. The activity reports will be subject to approval by the project supervisor. Approval failing, duly justified by the supervisor, will give INAF – OA Brera the right to terminate the contract;
- In case of resignation, he/she is required to notify in written form OA – Brera Director at least 30 days in advance of the expected date of terminating the appointment. If failing in this obligation, INAF/OA-Brera will be entitled to retain (or request the reimbursement of) the amount of salary corresponding to the fraction of the 30-day advance-notice period not fulfilled.

The holder of the fellowship who fails in carrying out her/his regular research activity, without producing justified reasons or lacks repeatedly to fulfill requirements or, according to the evaluation of the scientist in charge, eventually shows evident lack of skills at the planned research activities, will incur in the termination of the contract.

Temporary suspensions of the research fellowship are due in case of obligatory maternity leave or in case of illness lasting longer than one month or to any other serious reason. The reasons for suspending the research fellowship must be proved and certified, and promptly sent to the Director of INAF/OA-Brera.

Art. 11 – Personal Data

In accordance with art. 13, paragraph 1 of the Italian Legislative Decree n. 196/2003 and subsequent modifications, personal data provided by the candidates will be used exclusively for the purposes of this selection. Candidates who wish to obtain further information, or to exercise their rights under art. 7 of the above mentioned Legislative Decree, may contact the responsible administration employee for this call.

Art. 12 – Responsible Employee

The responsible administration employee for this job announcement processing is Mr. Luca Ciarfaglia

Art. 13 – Applicable regulation

INAF/OA-Brera shall abide by provisions in force promoting equal opportunities for women and men, non-discrimination and respect of privacy in processing personal data. For what not explicitly mentioned in this announcement, INAF/OA-Brera shall act in compliance with the regulations in force concerning Italian public selection procedures, when applicable by analogy.
