Selection procedure based on qualifications and possibly an interview for a scholarship (Borsa di Studio) as part of the **European Space Agency Mission "Euclid**"

# THE DIRECTOR OF THE "OSSERVATORIO ASTRONOMICO DI BRERA"

Taking into account	the INAF "Regolamento sull'amministrazione, sulla contabilità e sull'attività contrattuale" as of 24 Oct 2004;
Given	that the funding of the research fellowship will be guaranteed by the EUCLID project (funzione obiettivo 1.05.04.37.04)

## DETERMINE

## Art. 1

A selection based on titles and qualifications, possibly integrated by an interview, is open to award a 7month scholarship (Borsa di Studio) entitled **"Optimisation of the Euclid spectroscopic survey: impact of systematic biases on measurements of the growth of structure from redshift-space distortions"** at INAF-Astronomical Observatory of Brera (Merate and Milan).

One of the two main goals of the Eucid mission is the measurement to exquisite precision of galaxy clustering at different redshifts. The goal is to extract both the amplitude and relative importance of density fluctuations at different scales, together with their anisotropy produced in redshift space by galaxy peculiar velocities. These are key diagnostics of the dark sector.

The scholarship holder will contribute to the research being carried out by the Milan Euclid group led by Prof. Luigi Guzzo, exploring in particular the impact of redshift errors and other selection effects on the measured values of the growth rate of structure.

# Art. 2

The scholarship is expected to cover 6,5 months starting from January 1st, 2018. The gross total amount for this position will be 13,000.00 (Thirteen thousands) Euro. This amount is net of burdens to be charged to INAF/OA-Brera and will be paid in deferred monthly installments.

The above-stated amount does not include costs incurred for travelling within Italy or abroad for research purposes.

With regards to fiscal duties, the current rules of the sector apply.

The scholarship can not be combined with other checks and grants of a similar nature; besides, it is not a contract of employment and does not give any right to access permanent positions at INAF.

# Art. 3

Applicants must fulfill the following requirements in order to be eligible for the scholarship:

- PhD in Astrophysics or in an equivalent sector,
- Acquired expertise during the PhD thesis work on measuring and modeling clustering and redshift-space distortions in galaxy surveys.

Further, the following aspects will be considered as an asset:

- Good command of the English language.
- Previous experience in the same or in a similar field.

## Art. 4

Only applications received **by November 20th**, **2017** will be taken into full consideration. **Please quote reference** " **Optimisation of the Euclid spectroscopic survey: impact of systematic biases on measurements of the growth of structure from redshift-space distortions**".

The date of the email submission will be the one considered valid. Any incomplete applications or any applications submitted after the deadline will not be taken into account.

# The applicant must state clearly and precisely in the application form, under his/her own responsibility:

- name(s) and surname, date and place of birth, nationality, place of residence and address for correspondence (inserting also phone number, fax or email);
- date and University in which the PhD was/will be obtained;
- whether he/she is receiving other funds or other scholarships and, if so, detail their amount and duration.

# The applicant should send the following documents:

- A Curriculum Vitae, **signed and dated**;
- A description of the research activities carried out so far;
- A list of publications.

The applicant can also arrange to have <u>one letter of reference</u> by scientists familiar with his/her University studies and previous work experience, sent directly to the same e-mail address always by the same deadline.

The selection is based on qualifications, possibly integrated by an interview. Applicants selected for the interview will be summoned with 7 days notice by letter or telegram or email.

The committee will then proceed to select a winner, also drawing up a list of suitable candidates.

#### Art. 6

The winner will receive notification of the awarding of the scholarship by e-mail, letter or telegram. Within a deadline of seven days from the date of the its receipt, he/she must submit a statement to OAB of unconditional acceptance of the terms indicated in the call, otherwise he/she can lose the right to the scholarship. In case the acceptance is not submitted, or the scholarship refused, the Committee will offer it to the next candidate, following the order of the list.

## Art. 7

## Art. 8
